



# Jimmy Kilabuk Children's Recreation Fund

The Jimmy Kilabuk Children's Recreation Fund provides City of Iqaluit's children and families living with a low income the opportunity to participate in programs and activities at the Iqaluit Aquatic Centre.

#### **About the Fund:**

- Free annual family pool pass, valid for use at the Iqaluit Aquatic Centre (max two adults.)
- Fee assistance on City of Iqaluit Aquatic Centre programming for children 18 and under, to a maximum of \$150 per 12 month period, per child.

### Who Can Apply:

To qualify, you must meet the following criteria:

- Be a Nunavut Inuit;
- Be a resident of the City of Iqaluit;
- Be under the age of 18, residing in the same household as your immediate adult caregiver(s);
- The primary adult caregivers must be receiving financial assistance from the Government of Nunavut

## **How to Apply:**

- Complete the Application Form (available online) or get a paper copy from the Aquatic Centre's Guest Services Desk.
- 2. Bring a letter from your Income Support worker showing proof of Income and confirming residency.
- 3. Provide proof Nunavut Inuit status (e.g. NTI card or letter)
- 4. Visit the Guest Services Desk at the Aquatic Centre to complete your enrollment.

## **Frequently Asked Questions**

- What if I don't have children?
  - Currently, our primary focus is to provide pool and program access for families with children (children and their adult caregivers.) If you do not have dependent children, unfortunately at this time, you do not qualify. We may look to expand the program in the future however, and will be sure to make an announcement at this time.
- What if I'm not on Income Assistance?
  - Our primary goal is to ensure that children and families on Income Assistance receive
    access to our facility and programs. At this time, our program is targeted only towards
    those who are receiving Income Support.
- What if I have a child that is over the age of 18

- At this time, the passes are only for children under the age of 18, and their primary adult caregivers.
- What if my child does not live with me?
  - All children that are enrolled in the program must reside in the same household as their primary adult caregivers that are on Income Assistance.
- My child lives in another community. Can I get a pass for them when they visit me?
  - All children must reside in the same home as their primary adult caregiver to qualify for this program. This home must be in Iqaluit.
- What happens if we don't use the pass?
  - The must use the facility a minimum of three times per month in order to maintain your pass. If the pass is not used, the pass will be discontinued.
- Can I give my pass to someone else's kids?
  - No, passes are non-transferable. If the individual meets the criteria they are welcome to apply for a pass.
- What if my Access Card gets lost or stolen?
  - If you card is lost or stolen, please contact Guest Services immediately. You can get one replacement pass per year from Guest Services at the Aquatic Centre. If you need additional replacement passes after the first one, there will be the regular fee charged of \$20.
